1. From the remaining fabric and others included in the sampler block kit cut:

		4 patch	8	3" squares
		Star points background	8	3-1/2" squares
Stars	7225-RN (brown <u>hexies</u> print)	Points	4	3-1/2" squares
		4-patch	4	3" squares
Stars	7229-RK (black bud vine print)	Points	4	3-1/2" squares
		4-patch	4	3" squares
Green Chain	7223-RK		6	3" squares
	7227-RG		6	3" squares
	7228-RG		6	3" squares
Ribbon	7221-R	Corners	2	5-1/2" squares
		Half-squares	2	6" squares
Medallion	7222-R	Half-squares	4	6" squares
Gold Lace	7226-RO	Loose triangles	4	5-7/8" squares, cut once diagonally
		Corners	2	5-1/2" squares
Yellow Vine	7229-RY	Half-squares	2	6" squares

2. Make star points by using 4 brown hexies point squares and 4 star point background squares, make eight half-square triangle units as described in the General Directions. Trim to 3" squares.
3. Make star points by using 4 black bud vine point squares and 4 star point background squares, make eight half-square triangle units as described in the General Directions. Trim to 3" squares.
