

Prairie Rose — Grand Block Instructions

Each sampler block is set on point so you will need to complete each block by adding floater strips and setting pieces. There are two Grand Block versions, be sure to pay attention to the instructions for the color way version used to complete your block each month.

1. From the remaining fabric and others included in the sampler block kit cut:

2. Make star points by using 4 brown hexies point squares and 4 star point background squares, make eight half-square triangle units as described in the General Directions. Trim to 3" squares.
3. Make star points by using 4 black bud vine point squares and 4 star point background squares, make eight half-square triangle units as described in the General Directions. Trim to 3" squares.
