

# LOVE to you, Friends!

The fabrics used for this sweet Valentine wall hanging are from the Biscuits and Gravy line by Basic Grey for Moda Fabrics. The heart block centers are a fussy cut square from the lines alphabet panel.

You can piece as many hearts as you can creatively spell from a panel. ☺

Cutting for 1 heart block-finished size 7":

- 1 @ 3-3/4" x 3-3/4" center square (focus fabric)
- 4 @ 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A) background squares
- 2 @ 4" x 4" (B) background squares
- 2 @ 2" x 4" (C) red rectangles
- 2 @ 2-3/8" x 6" (D) red rectangles
- 1 @ 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" (E) red rectangle

1. Draw a diagonal line across the 4 – A squares. These are now your connecting corner squares.
2. Stitch a connecting corner A square to each of the top corners of the C rectangles. Trim away the excess fabric and press these seams open.
3. Stitch the two C units together as shown in the heart block diagram, represented by dotted line. Press this seam open.
4. Stitch the E rectangle to the bottom of the center focus fabric square. Press toward the E rectangle.
5. Stitch a D rectangle to each side of the center/E unit. Press seams toward the D rectangles.
6. Stitch the combined C units to the top of the center/D/E unit. Press this seam open.
7. Draw a diagonal line across the 2 – B squares. These are now your connecting corner squares.
8. Stitch a connecting corner B square to each bottom corner of the above unit. Trim away excess fabric. Press toward the B square.

If you are making the LOVE hearts wall hanging you will need the following cuts to complete.

- sashings: 3 @ 1-1/2" x 7-1/2"  
2 @ 1-1/2" x 9-1/2"  
2 @ 1-1/2" x 31-1/2"
- inner borders: 2 @ 1" x 10-1/2"  
2 @ 1" x 33-1/2"
- outer borders: 2 @ 3-1/2" x 16-1/2"  
2 @ 3-1/2" x 34-1/2"
- binding: 3 @ 2" x wof

Finished Quilt Size=16" x 40"
